General Information about University of Pitești

The University of Piteşti (UPIT) is a public multidisciplinary higher education institution, accredited, with legal personality, established in 1962. UPIT carries out teaching and research activities in different centers located in Piteşti, but also in other cities located in the South-Muntenia area, such as: Alexandria, Slatina, Râmnicu Vâlcea and Câmpulung Muscel.

UPIT is a medium size education higher instituion with nearly 9.000 students, 400 professors and 70 other employs. There are 6 faculties with 50 Bachelor's Degree Programmes, 51 Master's Degree Programmes and 11 doctoral fields (in: Philology, Sports Science and Physical Education, Automotive Engineering, Industrial Engineering, Materials engineering, Electronic engineering, telecommunications and information technology, Industrial engineering, Mechanical engineering, Mathematics, Informatics, Biology).

UPIT is member in the International Associations: European University Association (EUA), Agence Universitaire de la Francophonie (AUF), Danube Rectors' Conference (DRC), European Forum of Technical and Vocational Education and Training (EfVET), European Distance and E-Learning Network (EDEN), Association for Teacher Education in Europe (ATEE), International Association of Universities (IAU), Conseil European pour les Langues European Language Council (ELC), The China-Central Eastern European Countries Higher Education Institutions Consortium (CCHEIC).

Faculty of Sciences, Physical Education and Informatics has 14 Bachelor programmes (Biology, Chemistry, Medical Chemistry, Horticulture, Environmental Engineering, Physical Therapy and Special Motricity, Occupational Therapy, Nursing, Ecology and Environmental Protection, Energetics and Nuclear Technologies, Physical Education and Sports, Sports and Motor Performance, Informatics, Mathematics) and 12 Master programmes (Physical Therapy for People with Disabilities, Nuclear Materials and Technologies, Medical Biology, Monitoring and Environmental Protection, Forensics chemistry, Curricular and Extracurricular Motor Activities, Organization and Management in Sports, Performance in Sports, Advanced Techniques for Information Processing (in English), Modeling, Design and Management of Software Systems, Applied Mathematics, Didactic Mathematics).

Faculty of Mechanics and Technology has 4 Bachelor programmes (Road Vehicles, Manufacturing Engineering, Industrial Economic Engineering (Production Engineering), Traffic and Transport Engineering) and 6 Master programmes (Transport and Road Security, Automotive Engineering for Sustainable Mobility (English), Design and Management of the Automotive Projects, Materials Science and Technology (interdisciplinary with the fields of Automotive Engineering and Chemistry, in collaboration with Universite de Lorraine, France -Double Diploma - organized with the collaboration of 8 schools and universities in France such as: INP Toulouse, INPL Nancy, INSA de Lyon, ENSA Brest, École Centrale Paris, École Nationale d'Ingénieurs de Tarbes and Université Blaise Pascale de Clermont Ferrand, in French), Engineering and Management of Products Manufacturing, Logistics Management).

Faculty de Electronics, Communications and Computers has 4 Bachelor programmes (Applied Electronics, Communication Networks and Software, Computer Science, Electromechanics) and 3 Master programmes (Electronic Systems for Management of Industrial Processes, Electronic Engineering and Smart Systems, Energy Conversion Systems).

Faculty of Economics and Law has 8 Bachelor programmes (Business Administration, Economics of Trade, Tourism and Services, Finance and Banking, Accounting and Management Information Systems, Management, Marketing, Law, Public administration) and 10 Master programmes (Business Administration in Trade, Tourism and Hospitality, Management Accounting and Auditing, Management Accounting and Information Systems, European Economics and Finances, Financial-Banking and Insurance Management, Strategic Management of Human Resources, Strategic Management and Business Development (in English), Public Administration in the Context of European Integration, Juridical Careers, Contentious Law).

Faculty of Education, Social Sciences and Psychology has 9 Bachelor programmes (Pedagogy of Primary and Pre-primary Education (at: Pitești, Câmpulung Muscel, Râmnicu Vâlcea, Slatina, Alexandria), Social Work, Psychology, Journalism, Human resources) and 10 Master programmes (Educational Management (at: Pitești, Slatina), Educational Counselling, Early Education (at: Pitești,

Alexandria, Râmnicu Vâlcea), Clinical Psychology – Assessment and Intervention, Organizational Communication, Social Work Counselling, Health and Social Services Management).
