Is a public higher education institution, accredited, with legal personality, established in 1962. It has a non-profit character, is apolitical and has academic autonomy, in accordance with the legal provisions in force, being part of the national higher education system. In 2018, it received the High Degree of Confidence award by the Romanian Agency for Quality Assurance in Higher Education (ARACIS).

With over 55 years of activity in higher education, the University of Piteşti successfully pursues its mission to form highly-trained specialists for the education system, science, culture, economic and social activities, competent and competitive on the labor market in the country and abroad, responding to the demands of the contemporary society.

The 6 faculties of UPIT have 54 Bachelor's Degree Programmes, 51 Master's Degree Programmes and 10 doctoral fields organized in 8 doctoral schools, where approximately 10,000 students are enrolled.

UPIT carries out teaching and research activities in different centers located in Pitești, but also in other cities located in the South-Muntenia area, such as: Alexandria, Slatina, Râmnicu Vâlcea and Câmpulung Muscel.

- The University of Pitesti has an appropriate material base available to all students enrolled to Bachelor/ Master/ Doctoral programmes.
- Students are offered accommodation in UPIT student dormitories, and the canteen provides diversified food products at low prices daily.
- There is also a sport, recreation and physical recovery infrastructure held in well-equipped European multifunctional Center of UPIT. Here students can spend their free time to relax and practice different sports: tennis, football, handball, basketball, volleyball.
- Students benefit from psychological counseling and professional counseling services, monitoring the insertion of graduates on the labor market through the Center for Counseling and Career Orientation (CCOC).
- Students can be part of student associations as AIESEC.
- Optionally, the students can attend the courses of the psycho-pedagogical module managed by the Department for the Training of the Teaching Personnel (DPPD) and, thus, they can obtain the certificate that offers them a teacher career in the pre-university education system at all the levels.
- The library holds approximately 300,000 titles and facilitates access to the European Documentation Center, the State Office for Inventions and Trademarks (OSIM), Point d'Accès à l'Information founded by Agence Universitaire de la Francophonie (AUF).



The University of Piteşti holds the Erasmus Charter and offers students Erasmus + mobilities for over 20 years, since the implementation of the program in Romania. Every year, over 450 Erasmus+ study and placement mobilities (for students), teaching and training (for teachers) and training (for administrative staff) are offered.

UPIT has more than 500 inter-institutional agreements with 180 universities:
